# Scholarships *for* Nursing & Healthcare Majors!

This brochure highlights a few of the financial support opportunities available for COM students seeking education to become a nurse. Use this as a beginning resource and be sure to research other options available through the Financial Aid Office (ext. 274) and the College Foundation (ext. 508).

## **Mainland Medical Center Auxiliary Scholarship**

Two Scholarships Available

This scholarship is valued at up to \$800 per year (\$250 per semester for 4 consecutive semesters). Plus up to \$150 for each of the 4 summer terms (Summer I and II). The recipient must maintain a 3.0 GPA and be in good standing in COM's RN Nursing Program, and enroll in at least 8 credit hours each semester at COM.

## **Moody Foundation ADN/LVN Scholarship**

Two Scholarships Available (1 ADN/1 LVN)

This scholarship is valued at up to \$1,000 per year (\$500 per semester). The recipient must be in the ADN (2nd year)/LVN program, maintain at least a 3.0 GPA, and enroll in at least 8 credit hours each semester at COM.



## **Robert O. Biering & Edward Lalor Biering Nursing Scholarship**

This scholarship is valued at up to \$500 per year (\$250 per semester). The recipient must declare a major in nursing, have and maintain a 2.5 GPA, and must be a resident of Galveston County.

## **P.A. Schapper, Jr. Nursing Scholarship**

This scholarship is valued at \$1000 per year; \$500 per semester, for a maximum of 2 semesters (Fall & Spring). One award is available to a student who has declared Nursing as their major and enrolled in one of COM's nursing programs. The recipient must earn at least a 3.0 GPA and be enrolled in at least 8 credit hours each semester (excluding remedial courses).

## **Marcie Delane Suitt Memorial Fund Nursing Scholarship**

This scholarship is valued at \$1000 per year; \$500 per semester, for a maximum of 2 semesters (Fall & Spring). One award is available to a student in their second year of

the COM ADN Program. The recipient must earn a GPA of at least 3.0 and enroll in a minimum of 8 credit hours at COM.

## **Texas City Lions Club Nursing Scholarship**

**NURSING:** This scholarship is valued at \$1800 over 2 years, \$300 per semester for 4 consecutive semesters (Fall & Spring), plus \$150 for each of the 4 summer terms (Summer I & II). The recipient must declare a major in Nursing and be in good standing in COM's Nursing Program, must earn at least a 3.0 GPA, and be enrolled in 12 hours per semester (3 of which can be remedial). Incoming freshman from Texas City High School.

## **Miranda Denise Adams Memorial Scholarship**

This scholarship is valued at up to \$1000 (\$500 per semester for 2 consecutive semesters, Fall & Spring). The recipient must major in a health-related field, maintain at least a 3.0 GPA, and enroll as a full-time student for at least 8 credit hours each semester at COM. The recipient must also be a resident of Galveston County.

## **Michael Bruce Sullivan Scholarship**

This scholarship is valued at \$600 per year; \$300 per semester for a maximum of 2 semesters (Fall & Spring). One award is available, and part-time students are eligible to apply. The recipient must earn at least 6 credit hours each semester (no remedial). Preference is given to current year or past graduates of High Island High School, and second preference will be given to and Computer Science, NURSING, or other health-related major. There is no GPA requirement for application, except for students who have at least 2 college semesters (2.0 to apply). Once awarded, the recipient must earn at least a 2.0 GPA.
