

Carl D. Perkins Grant 2021-2022 APPLICATION for CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE

APPLICATION PRIORITY DEADLINE: SEPTEMBER 1st

The Carl D. Perkins Grant is provided by federal funds through the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 for the promotion of career and technical education (Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, 2010). The grant allots a maximum of <u>up to</u> \$125/week. To qualify for the Carl D. Perkins grant funding, students must meet <u>ALL</u> of the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in a career and technical certificate or degree program with an active degree plan on record.
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 on campus (face-to-face classes) credit hours. Developmental courses and enrollment in solely online classes are ineligible. "If due to unforeseen circumstances the college extends its online format, students will not be affected, and the college may continue to pay the daycare center. If a student temporarily keeps a child home from daycare due to quarantine of the child following the child's or a family member's exposure to or diagnosis of COVID-19, a college may pay a daycare center's invoice for the time the child would otherwise have been in daycare."
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress with a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- Complete a current year's FAFSA and be eligible to receive a Federal Pell Grant.
- Must have an unmet need before Carl Perkins Child Care Grant is awarded.
- Award must not cause student to exceed Cost of Attendance.
