OSHA's Top 10: #1 Fall Protection

Fall Protection has taken the top spot on OSHA's Top 10 list with over 7,000 violations cited. Falls remain the leading cause of death in the construction industry. Many have implemented additional training for site employees on fall protection use – but the numbers aren't changing quickly enough. If training is not the answer – what is? Learning how to minimize the risk of dangerous or fatal fall hazards allows an organization to take a proactive approach. This workshop provides an overview of: Effective fall protection programs, strategies for identifying/evaluating/controlling fall hazards, background on current standards, regulations, statistics & trends, all critical elements of a fall protection program, general information about fall protection equipment including equipment components, system development, anchorages, and clearance requirements.
