Due to uncertainties regarding COVID-19, your audition may be submitted via video recording.

In the event of a virtual audition, your video will be reviewed by an audition panel. Additionally, you may be contacted by the applied instructor regarding a possible Zoom follow up to occur on your selected audition date or at an arranged time.

Requirements for submission of your audition video.

- Announce your name and title of your piece clearly / slowly enough to be heard.
- Face the camera as you would face an audience, have a full body view.
- Video should be recorded in a neutral room.
- Videos recorded in bedrooms, bathrooms, or cars are **NOT** acceptable.
- Make sure the lighting in the room is bright enough for the panel to see you clearly.
- Dress in the way that you would for a job interview or attend a special school event.

Audition Videos should be submitted by March 30, 2021.

In person auditions will be April 3, 2021.

Audition Requirements:

Vocal: Accompanied singing of scales

Piece of vocal music in any style, accompanied or recorded accompaniment (accompanist provided with prior notification).

Guitar: Guitar (classical or electric with pick or fingers)

Two contrasting pieces from different eras.

Major scales in two positions and a short sight - reading piece.

Piano: Two Contrasting Pieces

Instrumental: Major Scales, Chromatic, Etudes / Solos – student must perform a solo from the Texas UIL Prescribed list (one fast and one slow)
