About the President's Ambassador Program

The President's Ambassador Program is a distinguished leadership opportunity allowing a select group of students to represent the positive image of the college at designated events and activities. Ambassadors will share their COM student pride along with the college's mission and culture with alumni, donors, friends, and community members. Ambassadors will represent the office of the president and College of the Mainland. This program provides a full scholarship to College of the Mainland for the 2021-2022 Academic Year which includes a \$500 book stipend.

An ambassador is a student who has a desire to work with faculty, staff, students, and members of the community. Ambassadors will assist with campus tours, new student orientations, special events, speaking engagements, and community service.

While serving in the President's Ambassador Scholarship program, students are able to:

- > Expand their communication skills
- Enhance leadership skills
- Work collectively as a team member with peers
- > Cultivate dynamic relationships

About the Application Process

This application packet has 4 sections:

- I. General Application
- II. Essay Questions
- III. Additional Documents
- IV. Duties and Responsibilities

Applicants must have earned at least 24 credits at College of the Mainland with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in order to be eligible for consideration. The application packet must be completed and turned in no later than 4:30 p.m. on April 1, 2021. Applications may be submitted in person to the gym lobby front desk or e-mailed to PresidentAmbassador@com.edu. All applicants must schedule an interview time with the Office of Student Life located in Gym Building #4 before the application deadline. Interviews will take place April 19-23, 2021.

PART IV: Duties and Responsibilities

Academic Expectations:

- Maintain full-time enrollment for the 2021-2022 academic year (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester)
- Maintain a Grade Point Average of no lower than 3.0 cumulative
- Remain in good academic and disciplinary standing with the College

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Work up to 19 hours a week. These hours will be accumulated by completing the following:
 - Mandatory weekly office hours
 - ➤ Leadership Development training
 - ➤ Weekly team meeting
 - ➤ Welcome Desk & Campus Tours
 - > Other tasks as assigned by the Department of Student Life
 - > Other meetings as needed for updates involving events and communication
 - ➤ Check COM e-mail daily and respond to e-mails in a timely and professional manner.
- 2. Attend mandatory events, including:
 - > Summer 2021 Ambassador Orientation Retreat
 - Assigned events throughout the academic year. Events and assignments may involve some weekdays, evenings, and weekends and will be distributed amongst Ambassadors as evenly as possible.
- 3. President's Ambassadors must commit to **one-year of service**.

Ambassadors are expected to display a willingness to help and serve throughout the year, going above and beyond as needed.
